Food Distribution Sites as of April 1st, 2020

Chesterfield County Public Schools (CCPS): CCPS will provide free meals to students while the school division is closed due to COVID-19 virus. Meals are for children ages 18 and younger, available for pickup at the specified school and community distribution sites, and will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis. Changes effective this week are as follows:

- **Children no longer have to be present to pick up meals.** To pick up meals without a student present, please tell the CCPS staff member your student's first and last names as well as their age.
- On Mondays and Wednesdays, two lunches and two breakfasts will be provided for each child.
- On Fridays, three lunches and three breakfasts will be provided for each child.
- **No meal service will be available on Tuesdays or Thursdays.**

Distribution occurs, Thursdays, 6 – 8:00 p.m. and Fridays, noon – 2:00 p.m. at the pantry located at 530 Southpark Blvd., Colonial Heights, VA 23834.
