The Romans Road to Salvation for Kids

Use these four main steps. You can read the verses together and ask simple questions after each.

1. We All Need Rescue

Romans 3:23 - “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”

Say to your child: “Sin is anything we do that’s wrong—like lying, disobeying, or being unkind. Everyone sins, and sin keeps us away from God.”

Ask: “Have you ever done something wrong? How did it make you feel?”

2. Sin Has a Cost

Romans 6:23 - “For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

Say to your child: “Sin leads to separation from God, but God offers us a gift—life with Him forever! We don’t earn it. It’s free because of Jesus.”

Ask: “What’s the difference between a gift and something you earn?”

3. Jesus Died for Us

Romans 5:8 - “But God shows His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”

Say to your child: “Even though we did wrong, God still loves us so much. He sent Jesus to take our punishment. Jesus died on the cross and came back to life.”

Ask: “What does it mean to you that Jesus died for you?”

4. We Can Be Saved

Romans 10:9 - “If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.”

Say to your child: “To follow Jesus, we tell Him we believe and want Him to be in charge of our lives. It’s a forever friendship with Him.”

Ask: “Do you believe Jesus is real and want Him to be your Savior and friend?”
