Celebrating Milestones: Salvation & Baptism

Your child has chosen to follow Jesus—what a joyful moment! Celebrating this step builds a strong spiritual foundation and helps guard against future doubts, especially for those who decide at a young age. It reminds your child that salvation is based on what Jesus has done—not on how much they remember.

Family Activities:

- **Create a Faith Keepsake Box** to hold photos, a baptism certificate, special letters from loved ones, and other meaningful mementos.
- **Share your family’s testimony.** Invite your child to write their faith story in their own words.

Family Talking Points:

- **What’s next after baptism? How can we grow in our faith every day?** (prayer, reading Scripture, attending church, sharing faith)
- **Who can we tell about Jesus? What does it mean to share the gospel?** (neighbors, friends, classmates)
- **What is the Lord’s Supper and why is it important? How does it help us remember Jesus’ love and sacrifice?**

Special Gatherings:

● **Baptism Celebration**

Invite family and friends to witness the baptism. After the service, host a small celebration with photos, dessert, and time to reflect on this meaningful step.

● **Spiritual Birthday Celebration**

Add your child’s “spiritual birthday” to your family calendar. Celebrate with a gift that supports their faith—like an age-appropriate Bible or devotional. Invite others who have played a role in your child’s faith journey.
