## **Celebrating Milestones: Starting Preschool**

Preschool is just around the corner! Whether your child attends a program or learns at home, it's a big day. Make it special with a fun breakfast and extra time together that morning. A calm, unrushed start creates space for meaningful connection and intentional discipleship.

### **Family Activities:**

- Surprise your preschooler with alphabet-shaped pancakes and pray over breakfast.
- Establish a simple goodbye routine—like a hug, high five, or “see you later, alligator”.
- Avoid packing too much into the afternoons those first few weeks. Give your child time to unwind from this big transition.

### **Family Talking Points:**

- What excites you most about starting preschool?
- Why is learning important? (God designed us to grow, explore, and discover new things!)

### **Special Gatherings:**

- **School Visit & Ice Cream Celebration**

Visit the classroom ahead of time to help your child feel at ease. Meet the teacher and let your child explore the space or try an activity. Then say, “You get to go back and play with that game you liked!” Follow the visit with an ice cream outing—invite grandparents or close family to join and make it a joyful memory.

- **Gift-a-Book Celebration**

Celebrate with a book-giving moment. Invite family and friends to gift a book and write a short prayer inside for your child as they begin this learning journey.
