I will get a sticker for my shirt.



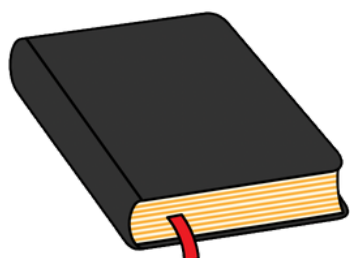

I will learn lessons about Jesus and we will do fun activities.

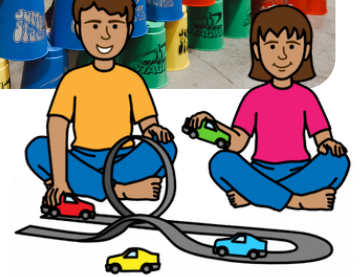




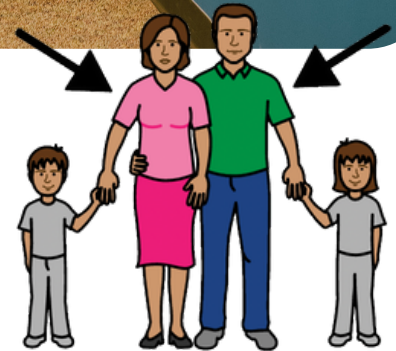
This is The Neighborhood!
