Leading Your Child to Faith in Christ

Your role as a parent is the most important influence in your child's faith. These five steps will help you guide them with confidence.

1. Lay a Foundation

- Read the Bible, pray, and sing about Jesus together.
- Model faith through love, choices, and daily life (Deut. 6:6–7).
- It's never too late to start building spiritual habits.

2. Discern Readiness

- Don't rush. Look for both **understanding** and **desire**.
- Wait until your child's head and heart align.

3. Ask Heart Questions

- Read Romans 6:23.
- Ask: *What is sin? How does sin affect us? How can we be made right with God?*
- Listen for understanding of:
 - **Jesus as Savior**—forgiveness of sin.
 - **Jesus as Lord**—leader of life.

4. Lead Them in Prayer

- Encourage your child to pray in their own words:
 - Admit sin.
 - Ask forgiveness.
 - Trust Jesus as Savior and Lord.
- Romans 10:9–10 promises salvation to all who believe and confess.

5. Prepare for Baptism

- Baptism is the next step after salvation.
- Celebrate their faith by scheduling baptism and marking this milestone together.
