# The Faith Game

## Overview:

Grab your family and play *The Faith Game*! Take turns drawing and answering questions about life, faith, and how you see God at work. There's no right or wrong answer — just real conversation that helps everyone open up and listen to one another..

## Instructions:

1. Print or write down these questions on slips of paper and put them in a bowl or jar.
2. Take turns drawing one and answering honestly.
3. Encourage everyone to share, and follow up with questions like “why?” or “tell me more.”
4. End by praying together, thanking God for what you heard or learned about each other.

## Faith Focus:

Faith grows stronger through conversation and connection. When families talk openly about what God is doing in their lives, it reminds everyone that faith isn't just for Sundays, it's something we live out together every day.

## The Faith Game Questions:

1. What's one thing that helps you feel close to God lately?
2. What's a Bible story or verse that's stuck with you recently and why?
3. Who's someone in your life who helps you grow in your faith?
4. What's one area of your life where it's hard to trust God right now?
5. What do you think it actually means to follow Jesus in middle school?
6. What's one thing that distracts you the most from spending time with God?
7. If Jesus came to hang out with our family for a day, what would we do together?
8. What's one way you've seen God at work in our family?
9. What's one way we can show kindness to someone this week as a family?
10. What's something about the Bible that confuses you or that you'd like to understand better?
